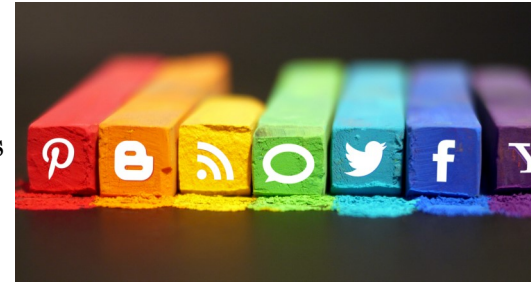

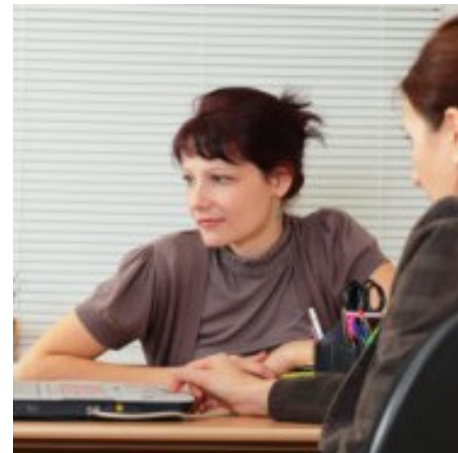


Developing a Teacher Voice October 26, 2017
